**In front of Giggly's house:
Hey little pig, come out and play.**

Don't stay inside; it's a very nice day.

**G: No, big wolf I won't play with you.
You're big and mean and ugly too.**

**W: Let me in you little clown,
Or I'll huff and puff and blow your house down.**

G: Not by the hair of your chinny, chin chin.

**W: OK, here goes -I'll huff
HUFF HUFF HUFF HUFF
And I'll puff:
PUFF PUFF PUFF
And I'll blow your house down
WOOSH! VA VA VOOM KAH BOOM!**

The house falls down and Giggly runs away to his brother's house.

Wolf chases G to F's house: Hey, you pigs, let me in.
